In his commentary on Pachomov's 1970 work, Kapanadze points out that this coin displays more careful artistry than the regular 1781 double pul'i issue, but a somewhat distorted Georgian and Persian legend. Kapanadze opined that this coin was prepared at the Ekaterinburg mint as a Pattern piece and sent to Georgia. This would have been much in advance -- by two years -- of Georgia's 1783 Treaty of Alliance with Russia, in which one paragraph touches on the production of Georgian monetary issues displaying Russia's Arms. Apparently, says Kapanadze, the Russian government had already made a decision on Georgia well before the official contract. (Pakhomov pp. 345-346).
